Clinical Review and Training

Enhanced/Advanced Provider Release

Requirements

The candidate will collect a minimum of **8 ALS** calls and run as AIC with an approved preceptor for a minimum of 8 shifts. The following categories and quantitative skills must be satisfactorily met in order to be considered for release.

- **One (1) calls with a presenting complaint that is traumatic in origin. Establish IV access**, oxygen administration, and complete spinal immobilization when applicable. Perform and document on the Clinical Thought Process Evaluation in the required format a history and physical exam pertinent to the complaint.
- Three (3) calls with a presenting complaint that is cardiac and or pulmonary in origin. **Establish IV access and oxygen administration** when applicable. **Administer medication by transdermal, nebulized, subcutaneous, or oral route**. Perform and document on the Clinical Thought Process Evaluation in the required format a history and physical exam pertinent to the complaint.
- Three (3) calls with a presenting complaint that is neurological/endocrine in origin. **Establish IV access and oxygen administration. Administer medication that is intravenous or intramuscular** when applicable. Perform and document on the Clinical Thought Process Evaluation in the required format a history and physical exam pertinent to the complaint.
- One (1) call with a presenting complaint of abdominal discomfort. **Establish IV access** and oxygen administration. **Administer IV/IM medication** for signs/symptoms associated with the complaint when applicable. Perform and document on the Clinical Thought Process Evaluation in the required format a history and physical exam pertinent to the complaint.
- Review Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP) guideline and powerpoint presentation. Complete CPAP quiz after review.
- Review EZ-IO guideline, complete EZ-IO quiz. Demonstrate use with a trainer.
- Quantitative evaluation of the following skills will be based on the "point" system.

Scene Management	40 points
Patient Assessment	40 points
Circulation	15 points
Medications	15 points

All calls will be reviewed by an approved Enhanced preceptor using the Advanced Life Support Evaluation Form. <http://warhammer.mcc.virginia.edu/cars/alspeval.pdf>

The preceptor will review the Clinical Thought Process Evaluation with the provider and complete the ALS Evaluation form. The documents should be attached to a copy of the PPCR for CRAT review. A Clinical Thought Process Evaluation does not need to be completed on patients in which the Junior provider does not act as the AIC. <http://warhammer.mcc.virginia.edu/cars/clinthou.pdf>

- A letter of recommendation from the candidate's primary preceptor endorsing their release.
- Any item in **red text** should be attempted by junior provider.
